Addressing Australian speaking pilgrims at today's weekly General Audience in Saint Peter's Square, the Holy Father said "I am close to the Australian people".

Response of the Church in Australia

Earlier this week, the president of the Australian Bishops Conference, Archbishop Mark Coleridge of Brisbane, issued a <u>statement</u> about the "unprecedented" crisis facing the country. Like Pope Francis, he too called for prayer, noting that "A genuine Catholic response to a crisis of this magnitude must draw strength from prayer which inspires concrete and compassionate action".

Archbishop Coleridge announced that the Bishops Conference is preparing a national response to the fires, including assistance to those affected by the fires, collaboration with aid agencies, and a special collection to be taken up this weekend. "With broad and deep roots across the nation", the Archbishop said, "the Church stands ready to walk alongside people throughout their journey of recovery".


