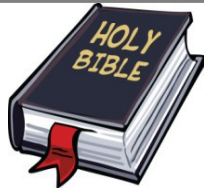

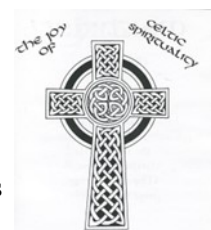

### 10 Week Course in Pastoral Liturgy Sacraments: Parish Celebrations on Life's Journey

*Sacraments: Parish Celebrations on Life's Journey* sets out to offer participants an overview of Christian Marriage; of Christian initiation for Children - their baptism as children; of the Order of Penance and of the *Order of Christian Funerals*.

This course will also look at some other elements such as the ministry of hospitality and welcome. The course consists of 10 two-hour sessions. It will begin on Wednesday 6 February, at 10.00 a.m. in the National Centre for Liturgy, St Patrick's College, Maynooth.

Following the class each day there is the Celebration of Eucharist in St Mary's Oratory at 12.05. Participants are welcome to take part.
