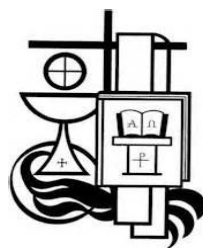


Annual Mass for the Deceased

Today is World Mission Sunday!

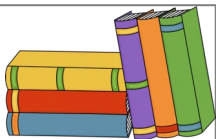

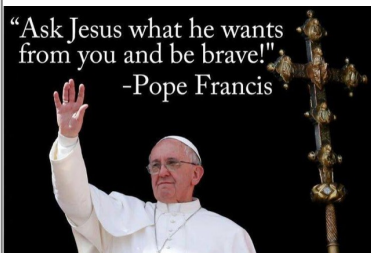
