For some months the five parishes of the Glasnevin Grouping have been discussing the introduction of some changes to our weekday and weekend Mass times. The hope is to enhance the quality of our celebration and to facilitate a priest in one parish being able to provide cover for Mass in another parish in the Grouping. The main change that will concern Iona Road Parish, is that each of the five parishes will have at least one weekday when there is no weekday Mass. In our parish this will be on Tuesday.

The changes are due to come into effect in Advent, the beginning of the Church's year. However, since both Fr. Paddy and Fr. Richard are going to be away for the first two weeks of November, we have been prompted to introduce the change earlier. This means that from this coming week, there will no longer be a Mass at 9.30am on Tuesdays.

Parishioners are invited to attend Mass at 10.00am in any of the other parishes in the Grouping (or the evening Mass at St. Alphonsus Monastery) or to take part in a Liturgy of the Word at 9.30am in our own church. The Liturgy of the Word will be led initially by a number of parishioners who are currently attending a course on presiding at Liturgy at the Margaret Aylward centre.

We regret the very short notice of this change, and the inconvenience

this may initially cause parishioners but trust that with time this will lead to a deeper familiarity with some of the other churches in the Grouping, as well as a confidence in the capacity of the Parish to gather to pray without a priest having to be present.
