

begins next Wednesday, Ash Wednesday. It is our period of preparation for Easter. Lent ends as we begin the Easter Triduum, the three days from Holy Thursday evening to Easter Sunday, with the Easter Vigil the high point. Fasting and abstinence have always been part of Lent, though with many variations. Gone are the days of Lenten Regulations, 'On all Fast days [every day of Lent except

Sundays and St Patrick's Day] only one full meal ... a light repast may be taken each morning and each evening.' Abstinence on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays: 'forbids the use of flesh meat or any soup made from meat ... '

But the importance of penance is still there, even without the Regulations.

The first few days give us time to decide -and still forty days to go.

Lent is the time when those women and men who will be baptised at the Easter Vigil enter a final phase of their journey of preparation. They give a powerful reminder to those already baptised that Lent is a time to recall their baptism and to prepare to renew our baptismal promises at Easter.

## Distribution of Ashes will take place on Ash Wednesday at the 9.30am Mass and also there will be a Service of the Word at 7.30pm during which there will be the distribution of Ashes.
