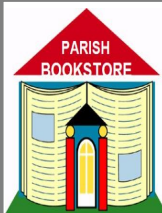

Good Friday Ecumenical Walk and Taize Prayer around the Cross:

On Good Friday evening, April 19, Archbishop Diarmuid Martin and Archbishop Michael Jackson (Church of Ireland Archbishop of Dublin) shall once again lead a silent walk through Dublin's city streets carrying a cross from Christchurch Cathedral to St Mary's Pro-Cathedral. This begins with a moment of prayer in Christchurch at 7.15pm after which the two Archbishops will quietly lead us through the city centre as they carry the cross of the ecumenical monastic community of Taizé across the Liffey to St Mary's arriving around 8pm. Those who wish can stay in the Pro-Cathedral for a meditative Prayer around the Cross with the chants of Taizé which lasts approximately an hour.
