



UCD Research to Improve Health with Ageing

The UCD Institute of Food and Health are recruiting adults to participate in a new research project which will explore the role of B-vitamins in healthy ageing. If you are aged 50 years +, you may be eligible to take part in an exciting 2-year trial to see if B-vitamins can benefit health as we get older.

Over the course of the 2-year trial, you will be asked to:

- Visit UCD on three occasions, each visit of 1.5 hour duration.
- Consume a free daily vitamin supplement.
- Undergo a free DEXA bone and body scan at beginning and end of the trial.
- Have your memory and blood pressure checked.
- Give a blood sample to allow vitamin analysis of your blood.
