

## Thought for the day

#### ....

In this section of the Sermon on the Mount Jesus proposes standards that go beyond external ways of behaviour but challenges how we feel in our hearts. When have you found that living out of inner conviction is more lifegiving than keeping up appearances?

Jesus applies his teaching to feelings of anger and sexual desire. He suggests that if we do not keep an eye on our feelings and thoughts we will not be able to control our actions. Perhaps you have experienced the truth of this. For Jesus, persons with genuine authenticity do not need to swear an oath to be convincing. Their 'yes' or 'no' suffices. Jesus insists that we go

deeper than our external deeds. The important question is what is going on in our hearts, the source of inner thoughts and motivations?
