## PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

To fill vacancies on our Parish Pastoral Council, we asked parishioners to express their interest in being considered for election as members and then, at stage two, we offered them a briefing on the working of the PPC and asking them to state their continued interest in letting their names go forward. Four parishioners have done this.

Since this number is less than the number of vacancies, they are deemed to be members of the PPC. Stage three, election at parish assembly if required, is not necessary. The nominations to the outstanding vacancies will be made shortly.

However the distinction between those on the panel of members elected and members nominated will be maintained and two names of the four new members from stage two will be drawn by lot and they will be regarded as part of the panel of members elected. This distinction will be relevant at the end of the term of appointment but does not impact on the deliberations of the PPC during their term of appointment as each member, elected or nominated, represents all parishioners and the interests of the parish.

The term of appointment to the PPC is three years, and is renewable.

Any vacancies during the term of three years will be filled by nomination
