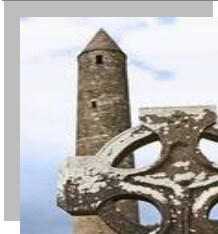


Dublin pilgrims, including ten young people sponsored by the Glasnevin Grouping of parishes, participated at the World Youth Day **'Hope of the future'**

KRAKOW, Poland — Pope Francis thanked World Youth Day organizers and volunteers and urged them to be "the hope of the future."

"I had a speech of five pages — but it's boring," Pope Francis said in Spanish, setting aside his prepared remarks. "Do you want to be the hope for the future? Well, there's no need to pay an entry fee — you just have to meet some conditions. The first is to preserve your memory: of your people, your family and where you come from, the memory of your journey and what you received from those closest to you. A young person without a memory isn't a hope for the future."

He thanked more than 15,000 organizers and volunteers and the estimated 50,000 priests and religious order members who accompanied pilgrims from around the world to the festival.
