

## St. Alphonsus Monastery

Sr. Monica Boggan celebrated her Final Profession of Vows on Saturday 27th July in the presence of her parents, family and friends. Bishop Jim Moriarty presided and the Principal Celebrant was Fr. Michael Kelleher, C.Ss.R. Archbishop Martin was represented by Sr. Elizabeth. The entrance hymn was "Shepherd of My Heart" and there was a formal entrance procession. After the Gospel Sr. Gabrielle stood in front of Sr. Monica and called "Monica" and Sr. Monica answered simply "Here I am". Sr. Gabrielle then said 'by the authority entrusted to me, I accept your vows in the name of the Church for this community of the Order of the Most Holy Redeemer.' Sr. Monica then took the Formula of Profession to the altar and signed it, followed by the signatures of the witnesses. She was then presented with the insignia of religious profession - the ring and the Holy Redeemer Medal. After the Prayers of the Faithful the Redemptoristine Community and the Redemptorists welcomed Sr. Monica as a full member of the Redemptoristine family. Mr. and Mrs. Boggan carried the bread and wine to the altar. The recessional hymn was the Magnificat. Mrs. Boggan and Sr. Gabrielle were presented with bouquets of flowers. The priests welcomed Sr. Monica by serenading her with "Vival". The Sisters sang beautifully and were accompanied by various instruments and a drum; Fr. Pat O'Donoghue was at the organ. A reception was held afterwards in St. Clements.
