A Note from Fr Paddy

I am delighted to see that provision is made at Sunday Mass for Communion for people with coeliac condition. It is an important pastoral concern as the prevalence of the condition is very high in Ireland. Communion with low-gluten Hosts may be received at the place where I am at Communion time. I use the expression 'low-gluten' though the amount of this protein is very low in these Hosts and they are often called 'gluten-free.' A person may be able to take these Hosts and medical opinion is advised. A person with the condition can also take the Chalice, with or without taking the Host.
