Reflection.. It is an obvious disappointment to us all that for the second year in a row we are unable to gather as a community of faith to celebrate the moving and powerful liturgies of Holy Week. It feels like we are living through a prolonged Lent, but perhaps it offers us new insight into the experience of the Israelites wandering in the Sinai desert, stranded somewhere between captivity in Egypt and the promised land.

As we enter into the mystery of Christ's passion and death, we are conscious of how many families in our own community have experienced this mystery of suffering, death and loss in the past year. We have been confronted with our powerlessness in the face of an invisible yet deadly virus. But the journey through Holy Week is always a journey of faith. While confronting the reality of pain, sickness and evil, we look to Easter and proclaim our faith in the resurrection. As we contemplate the mystery of God's love for us revealed on the cross, we rediscover the confidence to proclaim our hope.

Hopefully, parishioners will be able to join us via webcam for the Holy Week and Easter liturgies. You will note from the timetable of Holy Week in this newsletter that a ceremony will take place each night of Holy Week in one or other of the churches in the Glasnevin Grouping. We have put the webcam address of the particular church beside each service. RTE will also be broadcasting Easter ceremonies from the basilica in Knock. Included in the Easter mailing which has gone out to parishioners is a colourful activity card, which helps us to mark the different days of Holy Week at home or with the family.

As we journey through Holy Week, may we discover the companionship of the Risen Lord who walks with us. Fr Richard
