

Sr. Mary Margaret Quinlan R.I.P

Sr. Margaret died in the Monastery of St. Alphonsus on 19th August.

She was born on 22nd July 1933. A true Dub she spent her childhood on Marlboro Street and was baptised, received First Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Pro Cathedral. The family then transferred to Cabra where she attended the Dominican Convent. At 17 years of age she visited the Monastery and felt it was where God wanted her to be. Life was harsh. There was no heating in the Monastery but no one complained. The nuns rose at 4.30 a.m. and went to the chapel for Meditation followed by the Divine Office in Latin. Mass was at 7 a.m. and breakfast at 8 a.m. At 8.30 a.m. the Sisters went to their work places – Sr. Margaret was involved with the Altar Bread Department – making the batter, baking, damping cutting, sorting and packing. The Monastery then had three cows, hens, chickens, a dog and a cat. Happily after Vatican II the harshness was relaxed.
