

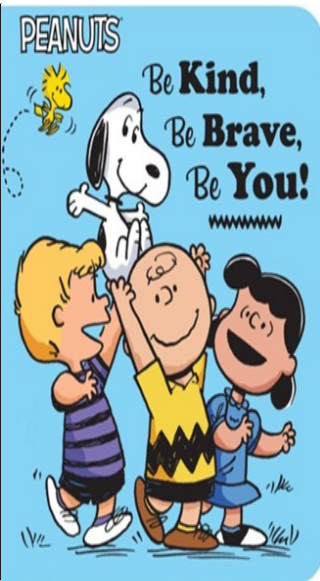


SEASON OF CREATION

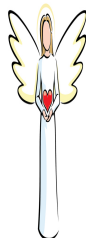

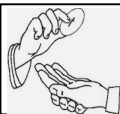
